REACH Regulation

The EU Registration, Evaluation, Authorisation and Restriction of Chemicals Regulation (REACH) came into force on June 1st 2007¹. Following the United Kingdom's withdrawal from the EU, UK REACH² came into force on January 1st 2021.

The majority of products supplied by each of the Ingredion EMEA Companies are classified as **food additives, food ingredients or feed materials**. They are therefore exempt from the scope and the main provisions of EU and UK REACH. Further products are listed on Annex IV and are exempt from registration regardless of their end use.

Further products that are used in non-food industrial applications include chemically modified starch polymers which are themselves exempt from any registration requirements. However, the monomers and other substances/materials used for manufacture may have registration requirements under EU and UK REACH.

As a downstream user of chemicals, each Ingredion EMEA Company collaborates with its suppliers (as appropriate) to ensure continued supply and support for the substances used in the manufacture of the products within our portfolio.

We can confirm that Ingredion UK Ltd and Ingredion Germany GmbH have registered the modifying chemicals necessary to ensure our compliance with EU REACH. The relevant registration numbers can be provided on request. With regards to UK REACH, Ingredion EMEA companies are working to ensure that requirements under this Regulation will be met.

Please Note: Customers purchasing food additives, food and feed ingredients and pharma excipients, which when used as such are exempt from EU and UK REACH Registration requirements, are responsible for compliance if the product is used in an alternative non- food/feed/pharmaceutical application.
